The proposal should provide the following information: title, motivation and objectives, topics of interest, confirmed papers (title, authors and abstract), contact information for the special session organizers, organizers' short biography, and a list of potential reviewers capable of reviewing papers submitted to the special session.

Proposals will be evaluated based on topic novelty and associated impact, organizing committee qualifications, as well as the proposed list of contributed papers. Special Session submissions will be reviewed via the same process as submissions to the regular program and papers are expected to meet the same quality standards
